Directions:

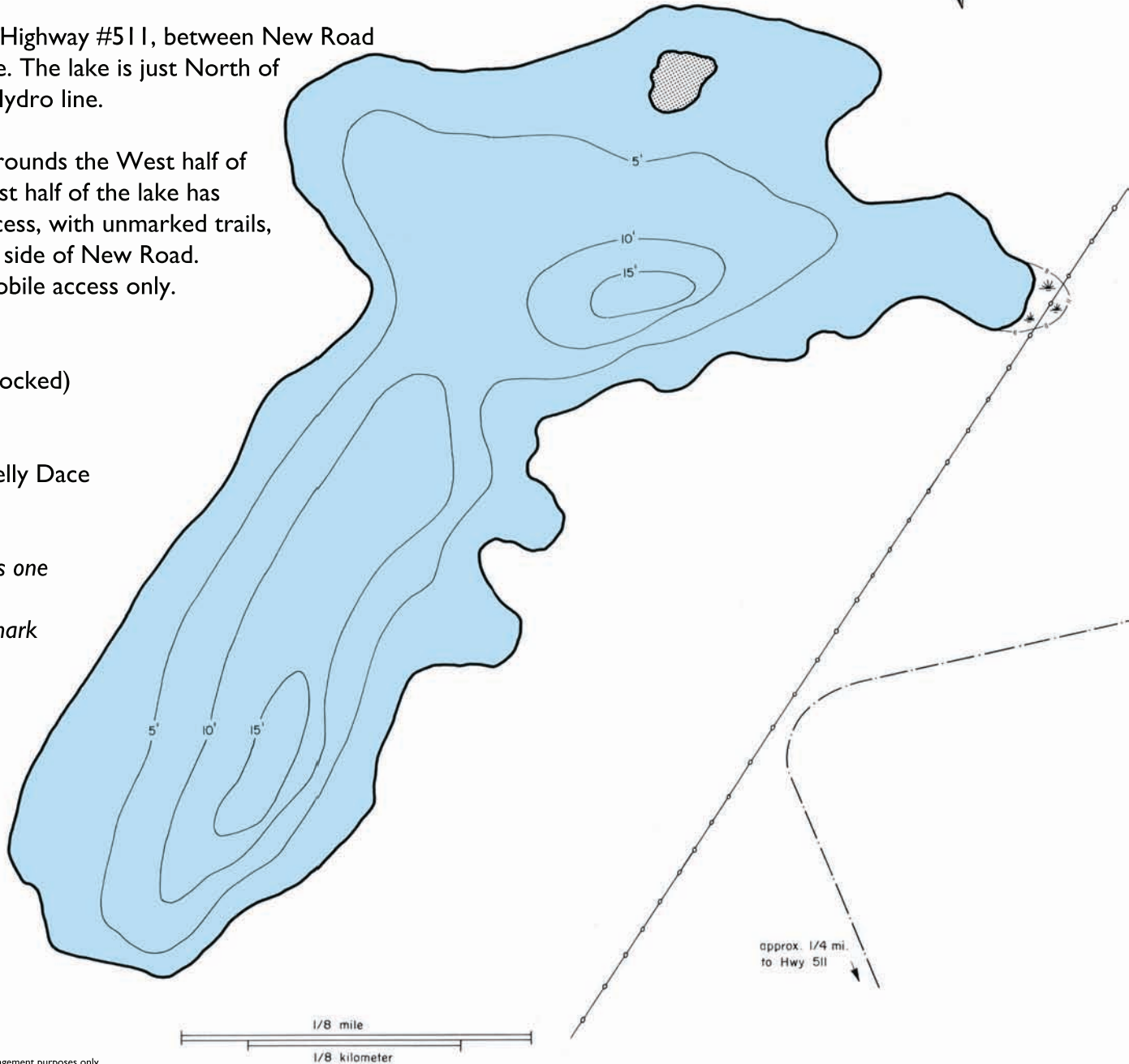
Located East of Highway #511, between New Road and Radley Lane. The lake is just North of a three-tower Hydro line.

Private land surrounds the West half of the lake. The East half of the lake has Crown Land access, with unmarked trails, from the North side of New Road. ATV or snowmobile access only.

Northern Redbelly Dace
Pumpkinseed
