



Silver Lake

Tay Valley Township

Surface Area: 608 acres
Maximum Depth: 80 feet
Mean Depth: 34.4 feet

Directions:

Located just North of Highway #7, approximately 5 km West of the village of Maberly. Access is available at Silver Lake Provincial Park, (Provincial Park fees apply). There is also a free gravel access point on the North side of Highway #7, less than 1 km west of the Park.

Fish:

- American Eel
- Brown Bullhead
- Burbot
- Lake Herring
- Lake Trout
- Northern Pike
- Rock Bass
- Smallmouth Bass
- White Sucker
- Yellow Perch



Silver Lake is a deep lake suited to cold water species of fish, with shallow, weedy bays suited to the warm water species such as northern pike, bass and panfish. This lake is stocked yearly with lake trout, and returns from these fish are quite encouraging, especially during spring and winter fishing. The warm water species are fished in the summer months with good success.
